

Our commitment to road safety

To ensure that our voice is heard in all aspects of road safety, SCARD works closely with Road Safety Units and has representatives on several road safety committees and panels furthering the aims of our members.

We also work with the Police, Probation Service, Emergency Services, Hospitals, Youth Groups, Schools and Youth Offending Teams informing them of the problems faced by victims of road death and injury.

We produce a Newsletter, sent out to all members informing them of any updates in legislation and law covering road safety and all matters affecting members.

We offer educational/rehabilitation workshops for every type of audience throughout the UK that are tailor-made for each audience. We can focus on different aspects of road/car crime and social responsibility and can cover any/all aspects within any given workshop which would be agreed with facilitator beforehand.
